The capabilities range from quick-change modules for aircraft and helicopters, that allow the conversion from VIP to ambulance mission within only a few minutes, to complex dedicated systems and installations for different emergency and air ambulance programmes. Spectrum holds a multitude of own STC's, from all Beechcraft King Air Series up to large aircraft like the Airbus A320 or Boeing 747. In the military sector Spectrum is the only company that received the general airworthiness release for the US-Air Force and the US-National Guard for all their ambulance aircraft.

In addition to the international marketing, Beechcraft Berlin is also able to install the systems in its own shop at the Berlin Tempelhof Airport or in partnership with different completion centers, and so offers full-service for any ambulance project.
